Dear Soldiers in Christ:

It's Youth Camp time again and we are hoping you can join us this year during the week of July 26<sup>th</sup> – July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010. This will be our eleventh year at Promise Land Camp in Conestoga, PA. The theme of camp this year is “**Get a drink from the fountain**” The theme verse is **Revelation 21:6** “***And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.***” We are praying that all of our young people will enjoy themselves and that God will get a hold of their hearts. Please begin to pray.

In this package there are the rules of Faith Baptist Church for Youth Camp. Please read over them, bring them with you to camp and distribute copies for everyone that wishes to attend camp this year. These rules include a list of items to help you pack. A permission slip is also included for you to copy for everyone. Everyone's permission slip will be needed as soon as they arrive at camp. Counselors will be needed for each group (a ladies for the girls and a men for the boys). If you cannot provide counselors for this week of camp please call me. The age limit is thirteen and up the cost will be \$90 dollars per person. Please make payable in one check for your whole group to Faith Baptist Church. For those not staying the whole week there will be a daily fee of \$20 dollars for food and activities per person. If a Parent needs to bring a sibling ages ten and under the price for camp for the child is waved, but there will be a \$2 charge per child for each meal.

Promise Land Camp charges us separately for some of the activities. We allow the teen campers to go to these activities as many times as offered throughout the week. Children under ten will only be allowed to do the charged activities once. If they (children ten and under) want to do more there will be a charge. Please see me for that cost at that time. Sometimes the activity bill is more than expected by the end of the camp week each year. So instead of charging our campers more money we ask that the churches pay the difference. The difference is calculated by the total due divided by the number of churches and split equally. So please be prepared to pay your churches equal share of the difference. Don't be alarmed this figure is not a large sum.

The canteen will be opened twice a day and youth choir CD's and tapes and Camp T-shirts will be available. So please advise each person to bring extra spending money if these are things they would be interested in.

Services will be held twice a day. Morning services will be for teaching or preaching and the evening services will be for preaching. Counselors please be prepared to preach or teach. Please notify your young preacher boys that they will be given opportunities if they wish to preach or teach. We do not have a special preacher each year. A preacher is picked the previous day for the main service as well as a young preacher for preaching or teaching. So be prepared.

You are more than welcome to bring a travel trailer or to set up tents but the cost of camp will remain the same.

We need to know in advance if you will be attending camp this year and how many will be in your group. Please let me know at least two weeks in advance.

Every year we have had the rule and posted on the rule sheet about no electronic devices, etc. One of those has included a cell phone. This year that rule will be enforced. No teen will be allowed to keep their cell phone. They should leave it home or turn it over to their counselors once they are at camp. They may call their parents during the week but must return the cell phone to the counselors after doing so. All parents should be given the parent contact sheet with all numbers should they need to contact their child at any time. Cell phone will be taken away, if the rule is not followed.
